Overview	<p>As one of China's premier business schools, RMBS boasts the longest history of management education in China, dating back to 1950. With close to 4,000 students and over 150 faculty members, it is the biggest and the most internationalized school among all 23 schools at Renmin University of China (total student population: 22,000+; ranked NO.1 in social sciences and humanities in China by the Ministry of Education).</p> <p>Our school has obtained both EQUIS and AACSB accreditations, and is placed the 43rd and the 13th respectively in the most recent FT rankings of EMBA and Executive Education programs. We offer two programs in English--BBA (Bachelor of Business Administration) and IMBA (international MBA).</p>

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Courses offered in English	<p>Previously, course options were mainly limited to our Bachelor in Business Administration program (for undergrads) and International MBA program (for graduate students), along with a Chinese language training module.</p> <p>Starting with Spring 2014 semester, incoming exchange students have access to courses taught in English at other schools in Renmin University of China, including the School of International Studies, School of Economics, School of Finance, School of Labor Relations and Human Resources, and Hanqing Advanced Institute of Economics and Finance.</p>

Course Load	<p>Course load of local students---</p> <p>1. MBA</p> <p>We require our full-time MBA students to get 47 credits (about 15 compulsories and 6 electives) in the first year, and have them focus on thesis-writing and field work in the second year. One credit is equivalent to 17 class hours.</p> <p>2. Undergraduate</p> <p>Starting from the 2012 intake, all local undergrad students have to take around 140 credits (instead of the previously 170 credits) before graduation (including 4-credit internship report and 4-credit thesis writing). The total number of required credits might slightly vary depending on different majors/specializations. On average, students should complete about 15-18 credits each semester.</p> <p>Normally, compulsory courses are 3-credit each, and elective courses are 2-credit each. 1 credit stands for 17 contact hours. For example, 3 credits course is "3 hours</p>

	<p>per week" for 17 weeks = 51 hours in total.</p> <p>In general, 1 Renmin credit is equivalent to 2 ECTS credits.</p> <p>We require undergrads to take at least 15 credits in the semester abroad, and graduate-level students to take at least 3 courses (no specific credit requirement).</p> <p>The course load for incoming exchange students, however, is at the discretion of the home university. We strongly advise that all incoming exchange students select at least 3 courses.</p>
